Proposal Elements

- Presenter name(s), affiliation(s), and contact info.
- **Title** of the presentation, paper, panel, or roundtable discussion.
- **Abstract** (300 words, maximum) that clearly describes the topic, objective, and target audience. For panels and roundtable discussions, indicate the operative format.
- Personal Bio (200 words, maximum) for each presenter.

Deadlines and Review Process

May 16: All Proposal Elements have been submitted to EasyChair. Reviewers begin to assess proposals.

June 13: Notification of Proposal Acceptance or Rejection.

July 11: Papers, slides, panel agendas, etc. have been submitted to EasyChair. Reviewers begin to examine and rate content, advising presenters of needed improvements, if any.

August 22: Notification of Content Acceptance or Rejection, with final suggestions for improvement.

September 18: Finalized Content due in EasyChair.

October 23: GLRC9 begins.

Session Duration

Time your presentation for delivery in 30 minutes or less. Session Chairs will not permit overruns.

Papers: Style and Publication

Authors seeking publication of their paper in INCOSE *INSIGHT* should use the INSIGHT Word Template and follow the Style Guide and Citation Guide, all available here: http://www.incose.org/ProductsPubs/periodicals/editorialguidelines.aspx

The current two-year backlog of articles for *INSIGHT* means that authors cannot expect immediate publication, even if accepted for GLRC9.

Clearances

Authors and presenters must obtain all necessary authorizations and clearances from their organizations, prior to the start of the conference. Papers and presentations shall be unclassified and cleared for release to the public.
