


Welcome to this small dokuwiki tutorial. By Joe Harth


To create a new page simply search for the page name. To delete a page simply delete all the content of the

page and save it.




To enable the DISCUSSION plugin on a page type `~~DISCUSSION~~`. Only enable the DISCUSSION plugin






