Consumer Privacy is a general-purpose CBDC that generates data about users' financial transactions in the same ways that [Commercial Bank](#) and [nonbank_money](#) generates such data today. In the CBDC [intermediated](#) that the Federal Reserve would consider, intermediaries would address privacy concerns by leveraging existing tools.
