This week we went through a number of different scenarios in which we may want to cross reference terms in FIBO to those in normative external standards.

Will have “Treatments” for each of a number of scenarios:

- Standard ontologies where
 - We want to use only a small subset of the terms
 - We want to use the whole thing
 - We want to use one aspect of the ontology (e.g. classes but not axioms)
- 2. Standard ontologies which are:
 - Well modeled in OWL
 - Not well modeled but presented in OWL
 - Not in OWL but still ontologies
 - Standards which are not formal ontologies

Other considerations include

- Degree of adoption or uptake of the standard
- How authoritative it is for its subject matter
