Purpose

The [goal](#) of this specification is to define the means for applications using standard web protocols to participate as first-class citizens as publishers and subscribers of data in the [data_distribution_service_dds](#) Global Data space. This participation is realized by exposing a WebDDS Object Model and making it accessible as a web service, a [REST](#) resources, or some other standard web [protocol](#). Exposing access via these web-friendly protocols allow applications built on various technology stacks (e.g. JavaScript, Python, PHP, Perl , etc.) to communicate with native DDS applications.

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
