

Gateways for DDS

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OMG: Web-Enabled DDS (DDS-WEB)	defines a platform-independent Abstract Interaction Model of how web clients should access a Data Distribution Service (DDS) System and a set of mappings to specific web platforms that realize the Platform Independent Model (PIM) in terms of standard web technologies and protocols.
OMG: OPC-UA/DDS Gateway (DDS-OPCUA)	defines a standard, configurable gateway that enables interoperability and information exchange between systems that use DDS and systems that use Open Platform Communication Unified Architecture (UPC-UA) .
OMG: DDS For Extremely Resource Constrained Environments (DDS-XRCE)	defines the protocol used by a resource constrained, low-powered device (client) to publish and subscribe data to a DDS Domain . The XRCE protocol connects the XRCE client to a DDS Agent that acts as the gateway to the DDS Domain.

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
