

# Gateways for DDS

<b>ddsweb</b>	defines a platform-independent Abstract Interaction Model of how web clients should access a DDS System and a set of mappings to specific web platforms that realize the Platform Independent Model (PIM) in terms of standard web technologies and protocols.
<b>ddsopcu</b>	defines a standard, configurable gateway that enables interoperability and information exchange between systems that use DDS and systems that use OPC UA.
<b>ddsxrce</b>	defines the protocol used by a resource constrained, low-powered device (client) to publish and subscribe data to a DDS Domain. The XRCE protocol connects the XRCE client to a DDS Agent that acts as the gateway to the DDS Domain.
