

# Performance

**Performance** is the ability of a system to accomplish the required functionality at or under the required specification limits. The limits are generally provided relative to time. For example, so-many transactions per second, so-many updates per millisecond, so-many recorded entries per second, etc. The specifications can also include accuracy, precision, precision or even efficiency of other dependent systems as requirements.
