

Abstract

The excitement, expansion, and advancement in Distributed Computing resulting from Satoshi Nakamoto's paper "Bitcoin: A Peer-to-Peer Electronic Cash System"¹⁾ paper has highlighted the need for a Reference Architecture (RA) focused on Distributed Immutable Data Objects (DIDO)s, where it is understood that DIDOs include, but not limited to cryptocurrencies, the original blockchain, and distributed ledger technologies.
