

3.3 Guides

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In addition to the legal documents governing the activities of a [Community of Interest](#), many Cols will create a simple, easily understood Guide to help its members maneuver through and understand all the governing statements contained in the statutes, Charter, Bylaws, Parliamentary Authority, Special Rules, Custom Practices, and Standing Rules associated with that particular Col. For example, the OMG publishes a "[Hitchhiker's Guide to the OMG Process](#)". Even though it is not a "normative" document (has no legal standing whatsoever, can not be cited as a defense for not following process), it is much easier to read and understand than the [OMG's Policies and Procedures](#). It provides additional details and insights that, even though they do not belong in a P&P, are essential to know. Technical standards bodies such as the [IETF](#) publish a similar Guide, which is even more informal and flippant. In any case, the goal of such a Guide is to make it easier for the members of a Col to follow their Col's process rules.

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
