An **application programming interface (API)** is a set of protocols, routines, functions and/or commands that programmers use to develop software or facilitate interaction between distinct systems. APIs are available for both desktop and mobile use and are typically useful for programming [gui](#) components, as well as allowing a software program to request and accommodate services from another program.
