Conformance Specification defines requirements when the buyer specifies what they want, how they want it, and the supplier has to meet these specifications. In contrast, see [Performance or Functional Specifications](#).

Examples of conformance specification are:

- Engineering drawing
- A chemical formula
- Model name, number or brand etc
