A **Database Driver** is a computer program that implements a [protocol](#) ([Open Database Connectivity \(ODBC\)](#) or [Java Database Connectivity\(JDBC\)](#)) for a database connection. The driver works like an adaptor which connects a generic [interface](#) to a specific database vendor implementation. ... To connect with individual databases, JDBC requires drivers for each specific database type
