

Deadline QoS

Deadline QoS is a significant parameter for periodic and aperiodic real-time critical communications. This represents the maximum separation between two [topic](#) updates. The [Data Writer](#) indicates that the [application](#) commits to write a new value at least once every deadline period. The [Data Readers](#) are notified by the [Data Distribution Service \(DDS\)](#) engine when the Deadline [Quality of Service \(QoS\) Policies](#) contract is violated.
