A **Domain** is a communication context, which provides a virtual environment, encapsulating different concerns and thereby optimizing communications. [Data Distribution Service \(DDS\)](#) applications send and receive data within a domain, which provides a virtual communication environment for participants having the same domain [Identifier \(ID\)](#). This environment also isolates participants associated with different domains, i.e., only participants within the same domain can communicate, which is useful for isolating and optimizing communication within a community that shares common interests.
