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History QoS Is a [QoS policy](#) that specifies the number of samples kept by the [middleware](#) engine. [Data Distribution Service \(DDS\)](#) will only attempt to keep the most recent 'depth' of samples (KEEP_LAST) or ALL samples (KEEP_ALL) of each [instance](#) of data identified by its [key](#).
