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**Hybrid Network** is unique in that it is decentralized while also making it possible to restrict the visibility of information on the network with a combination of [Public](#), [Private](#), [Permissionless](#) and [Permissioned](#) Networks. Thus, a hybrid [blockchain](#) is appealing for regulated markets as it offers the benefits of public blockchain and private blockchain together.<sup>1)</sup>
