Knowledge Factor is part of [Multifactor Authentication \(MFA\)](#) and includes all things users must know in order to log in to gain access to a system. This includes Usernames, IDs (i.e., Passport or Driver's license numbers), passwords, and personal identification numbers (PINs), answers to security questions(i.e., your favorite sport), or information derived from [Personal Identifiable Information \(PII\)](#) (i.e., mother's maiden name, oldest child's middle name).
