

Open Standard Authorization (OAuth)

Open Standard Authorization (OAUTH) is an authorization [protocol](#) - or in other words, a set of rules - that allows a third-party website or [application](#) to access a user's data without the user needing to share login credentials.

OAuth's open-source protocol enables users to share their data and resources stored on one site with another site under a secure authorization scheme based on a token-based authorization mechanism. OAuth is also known as OAuth Core.
