**Permissionless Networks** require no permission to use it. In other words, there is no barrier to entry to use it. Anyone can run a node, run mining software/hardware, access a [wallet](#) and write data onto and transact within the blockchain (as long as they follow the rules of the blockchain). There is no way to censor anyone, ever, on the permissionless [bitcoin](#) blockchain.<sup>1)</sup>
