

Software Adaptability

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Software Adaptability is when software components with a well-defined, stable [Application Programming Interface \(API\)](#) can be exchanged using another components with minimal effort as long as the component adheres to the API. For example, [SQL](#) describes an API for a database component. As long as the software adheres to the standard SQL API, the [DataBase Management System \(DBMS\)](#) can be exchanged from Oracle to [PostgreSQL](#) with no to minimal impact.¹⁾
