A **Uniform Resource Identifier (URI)** is a strings of characters used to identify names or resources (i.e., [Shared Resources](#)) on the [Internet](#). The **URI** describes the mechanism used to access resources, the computers on which resources are housed, and the names of the resources on each computer.
