ira (/ˈdʒiːrə/ JEE-rə¹⁾) ¹⁾ is a proprietary issue tracking product developed by Atlassian that allows bug tracking and agile project management. The product name is a truncation of *Gojira*, the Japanese word for *Godzilla*, ²⁾ which is a reference to a competitor, *Bugzilla*.
