

3.1 Naming Conventions

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- Names should always be in Title Case (i.e., the first letter of each word is uppercase all others are lower case). See [Title Case](#)
- One blank between all words
- Underscores between words should not be used unless it is part of a recognized Name
- Hyphens can be used between words
- Avoid the use of abbreviations (i.e., Id versus Identifier)
- Avoid the use of plurals (i.e., Argument List versus Arguments, or Uncle versus Uncle List)

Some examples are:

- Identifier
- Transaction Index
- Block Number

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
