

## 3.2 Reserved Words

**Reserved Words** (also called keywords) have predefined meaning within DIDO-CLI. These keywords are usually used as part of the DIDO-CLI instructions. Reserved words should not be used as identifiers for other elements like name of ports, [objects](#), Oracles, etc. since it will not always be clear from the context if the **Reserved Word** meaning is desired or the specific element.

- **Note:** Each of these **Reserved Word** meanings are provided in the [Grammar section](#). The meaning of the Reserved Word is variable depending on the context. The meaning of the word VOID is context-sensitive.
